# Flora Britannica



- ✿ A mix of 100% native and naturalised species found in the British Isles
- ✿ For creating natural, flower rich meadows
- ✿ Good for ecological renovations

Recommend to be sown along rural roadsides, nature reserves, ecological conservation schemes, riverside edges, on agricultural set-aside land and natural areas of parkland. **Flora Britannica** is a universal mixture meaning its plant base is common to many habitats throughout the UK.

It also can be sown together with other Euroflor flower mixes for green infrastructure projects or with specialist habitat species such as wetland, acid, shade, or chalk land flower species

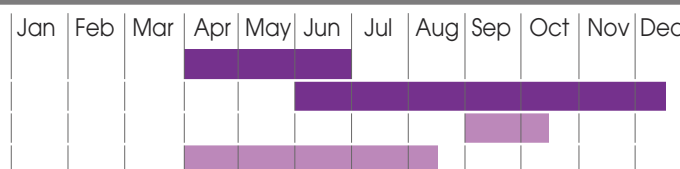
