



Spring Flower

- ❖ Sow in autumn for earlier spring flowering, or sow in spring for summer flowering
- ❖ Capacity to flower twice per year if cut back after flowering
- ❖ Provides ground cover vegetation over winter

Spring Flower comprises species, which can be sown during autumn to provide earlier spring flowers and with the added benefit of ground cover vegetation over winter as the plants are resistant to frost. Flowers start blooming in early spring and continue into early summer. Highly recommended for sowing in proximity to compliment spring sown Euroflor mixes for example, in bands to benefit from extended seasonal flowering from spring through to the first frosts on the same plot.




Spring Flower Characteristics
