- ✿ Low growing meadow (50-70cm)
- ✿ A rich mix of annuals, biennials and perennials
- ✿ Long flowering period

Tenor gives a proven flowering performance from early summer to mid-autumn, peaking in mid-summer with an excellent display of Poppies and Cornflowers, followed by yellow flowering Coreopsis and Calendulas in autumn.

It's formulation will satisfy those who want to see the use of native and naturalised plants (Poppy, Cornflower, Oxeye Daisy, Yarrow, Corn Cockle, Forget-me-Not, Perennial Flax, Wild Candytuft) combined with horticultural varieties that will extend the flowering season.


