What is Euroflor?

- **%** Urban flower mixtures
- Cultivated varieties of garden flowers plus naturalized species
- № 100% flowers
- * European seed production



- **%** Germination-tested
- Majority are annuals plus a few perennials
- * Provides a display from late spring to late autumn

Applications

- **%** Urban flower meadows
- High impact displays parks, gardens, cemeteries, verges and roundabouts, memorials, flower beds, ground cover, etc.
- Annual succession schemes provide impact and year-onyear flexibility







What is Flora Native?

- ★ Environmental wildflowers
- Purely native and naturalized species
- W UK Provenance (Produced under the `Flora Locale' Code of Practice)



- Not germination-tested but subject to quality assurance procedures
- & Annuals, biennials, perennials
- * Provides an early spring to late summer display

Applications

- Creates and restores ecological habitats reclamation schemes, SuDs, solar farms, road & rail verges, golf course roughs, country estates, moorland, etc
- Recommended for long term persistency and specialist habitats

Flora Native Plug Plants

The new range of Rigby Taylor Flora Native Wildflower plug plants are now available in trays containing single or mixed species.

- ♣ Trays of 25, 50, 150 or 500 plants
- Single or mixed species for diverse habitats
- Species subject to seasonal availability

On Arrival: Open trays immediately, lightly water and place in sunlight until required for planting.

Preparation:grass down to 10cm during plant establishment to reduce smothering and competition.

Planting: Can be undertaken at any time of the year providing the soil is moist. Ideal timing is the autumn or spring. If planting in summer, ensure water is available if conditions become hot and dry. Remove plugs from the tray by gently squeezing each one from the base and slowly pull out. Using a trowel or dibber, make a hole as deep as the plug itself and gently insert. Plant at a density of 5-7 plus per square metre. Firm the soil around the plug and water-in to prevent drying out.
