## Rounders

## BATTING AREA

12m (13.12yd) square.

## RUNNING TRACK

Mark a solid line extending from the front right hand corner of the batting square to the 1 st post measuring 12 m ( 13.12 y ) in length. The same line will be extended past the first post for 2 m (2.19yd). The distance from the batting square to the second post and the first post to the third post is 17 m ( 18.59 yd ).

The 4th post measures in a straight line from the third post 8.5 m ( 9.3 yd ) and extended 2 m (2.19yd) over the frontline of the batting square. The lines from the 1st post to the 2nd post and from the 2nd post to the 3rd post will also be extended 2 m past the 2 nd and 3 rd post respectively.

## BOWLING SQUARE

Measures 2.5m (2.73yd) square.

## BATTING SQUARE

Measures 2 m (2.19yd) square. The front line of the
batting square extends a minimum of 12 m ( 13.12 y ) in either direction. The area in front of this line toward the bowling square is called the Forward Area and the area behind it called the Backward Area.

The front line is parallel with, and 7.5 m (8.2yd) away, from the front line of the bowling square.

## BATSMEN OUTLINE AND WAITING LINE

Measures a minimum of 10 m ( 10.94 yd ) behind the front line of the batting square and 15 m (16.4yd) on both sides from the front-right hand corner of the square. They are then marked 2 m (2.19yd) long from that point.

## POSTS

Placed 1.2 m ( 1.37 yd ) above the ground. They shall be supported in a base and not fixed in the ground.

## LINE WIDTH

Recommended 2.5 cm ( 0.98 in ) minimum to 5 cm (1.97in) maximum.

## COLOUR

White lines are suggested but not specified.
