COURT MEASUREMENT

Doubles and singles: 23.77m (78ff) long by 10.97m (36ff), including the width of the lines.

A diagonal check measurement can be done to assist in setting out the courts. This measurement is taken from the point where the net and outside sideline intersect to the opposite corner of the court.

For singles, that measurement would be 14.46m (15.81yd) and for a doubles court would measure 16.18m (17.69yd).

CENTRE SERVICE LINE

Length 12.80m (14yd). The line is parallel to the sidelines directly in the middle of the court and meets perpendicularly at the service lines.

CENTRE MARK

Length 10cm (3.9yd) marked directly in the middle of the baselines at both ends of the court.

SERVICE LINE

Measures 6.4m (7yd) from the centre of the court and

8.23m long, on either side of the Centre Service Line.

TRAMLINES

Measures 1.37m (1.5yd) from the outside edge of the sidelines on either side of the court.

RUN-BACK

Recommended maximum 6.4m (7yd), minimum 5.49m (6yd).

SIDE RUN

Recommended maximum 3.66m (4yd), minimum 3.05m (3.4yd).

NET

Height 0.914m (3ff). Length: 12.8m (42ff).

LINE WIDTH

5cm (1.97in) wide.

LINE COLOUR

White.
