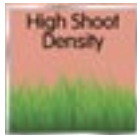

Ultra-fine rye and fescues

Clementine ultra-fine perennial ryegrass blends perfectly with fine fescues to produce a fast establishing, drought tolerant, dense sward with increased wear tolerance. Hard fescue is excellent for recovery from drought and helps maintain healthy winter colour.

The Mixture

30%	Clementine	Perennial ryegrass
25%	Greensleeves	Chewings fescue
15%	Beudin	Slender creeping red fescue
20%	Hastings	Strong creeping red fescue
10%	Dumas 1	Hard fescue

Sowing Rate: 25-35g/m²
 Overseeding Rate: 15-25g/m²
 Sowing Depth: 4-6mm
 Mowing Height: Down to 7mm

The Cultivars

Clementine A stand-out cultivar for cleanness of cut and shoot density
Greensleeves High shoot density, good winter colour, early spring green-up, high salt tolerance for the species
Beudin High shoot density, consistent mid-green colour summer and winter
Hastings Fast establishing with rhizomatous recovery
Dumas 1 Excellent drought, salt and shade tolerance

› Golf tees and the general area including fairways, short roughs and driving ranges
