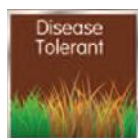
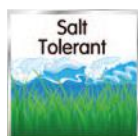
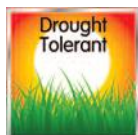

#### 100% fescue blend

This high shoot density, salt tolerant blend of fescues includes hard fescue for excellent recovery from drought and good winter colour. With strong creeping red fescue for faster establishment, the genetic colour of this multi fescue blend gives greater consistency summer and winter.

#### The Mixture

30%	Greensleeves	Chewings fescue
20%	Absolom	Slender creeping red fescue
20%	Hastings	Strong creeping red fescue
30%	Dumas 1	Hard fescue

Sowing Rate: 20-30g/m<sup>2</sup>  
 Overseeding Rate: 10-20g/m<sup>2</sup>  
 Sowing Depth: 4-6mm  
 Mowing Height: Down to 7mm

#### The Cultivars

**Greensleeves** High shoot density, good winter colour, early spring green-up, high salt tolerance for the species

**Absolom** Best in class for visual merit and excellent tolerance to Red Thread disease

**Hastings** Fast establishing with rhizomatous recovery

**Dumas 1** Excellent drought, salt and shade tolerance

#### Where to use

› Golf tees and the general area including fairways and roughs

#### How it performs

- › Increases sward density, drought and salt tolerance
- › Improves tolerance to Red Thread disease
- › Genetic colour gives greater consistency summer and winter
- › Tolerant of shade and a wider range of pH
- › Early spring green-up and recovery
- › Sow at 10g to create open, playable deep roughs
- › Produces attractive fescue flower heads for deep roughs

### HARD FESCUE

*Festuca trachyphylla*

A highly drought tolerant fescue with fine leaves, high shoot density and tufted growth habit. Thriving in a wide range of soil pH and with good salt and shade tolerance, hard fescue is very winter hardy and particularly useful for infertile soils, low maintenance and sustainable golf course management. Cultivars such as Dumas 1 will tolerate closer mowing. Good winter and spring colour.
