Ultra Low

Fine fescues and bents

This fine fescue/bent mix has early spring green-up, good winter colour and improves density, drought and disease tolerance. It requires very low inputs in terms of nutrients and water once established.

The Mixture

40%	Hastings	Strong creeping red fescue
30%	Greenmile	Chewings fescue
25%	Dumas 1	Hard fescue
5%	Egmont	Browntop bent

Sowing Rate: 25-40g/m²
 Overseeding Rate: 10-20g/m²
 Sowing Depth: 4-6mm
 Mowing Height: Down to 7mm

The Cultivars

Hastings	Faster establishing with rhizomes for recovery
Greenmile	Good winter colour, early spring green-up, improves tolerance to Microdochium and Red Thread diseases
Dumas 1	Excellent drought, salt and shade tolerance, good winter colour
Egmont	Excellent winter colour, increases tolerance to Microdochium disease

› Tees and the general area, including fairways and short roughs
